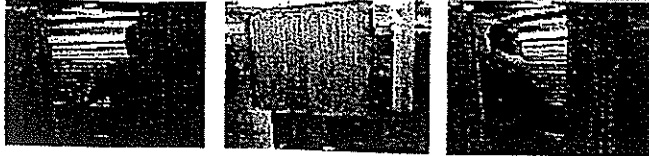


Directions for Voting on the Voting Machine

SAMPLE BALLOT

Swing the handle of the curtain lever from the left to the right as far as it will go, and leave it there. (This will close the Curtain around you, and unlock the machine for voting.)



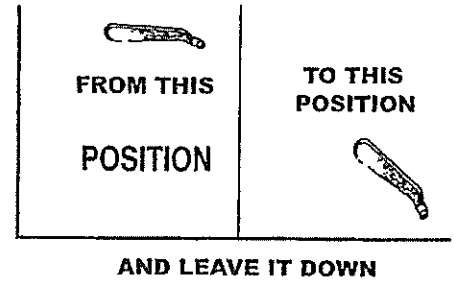
A FEW WORDS OF EXPLANATION

If the voter wishes to vote for any person whose name does not appear on the ballot, he/she may do so by raising the slide above the office column. This exposes a portion of the paper on which the voter may write the name of his/her candidate. No name of a candidate printed on the ballot may be written in for the same office.

Once a write in slide has been raised, all levers for candidates in the same column are automatically closed and cannot be used. No votes are registered until you swing the curtain lever to the left to open the curtain. You can, therefore, make as many changes in your ballot, EXCEPT WRITE-IN'S, as you wish while the curtain lever is at the right, (curtain closed).

Each candidate's voting pointer is above his/her name. Each proposition has its own voting lever over YES or NO. No vote will be registered for any candidate or proposition except those that have pointers left in the down position.

There is no danger of anyone knowing how you vote as the movement of the Curtain Lever from right to left returns the voted pointers to their un-voted position before curtain begins to open.

<p><input type="checkbox"/> YES <input type="checkbox"/> NO</p> <p>PROPOSITION NO. 1 2015-2016 JERICO UFSD BUDGET</p> <p>RESOLVED, that the School District Budget as submitted for 2015-2016 in the amount of \$121,185,238 and the levy and collection of necessary taxes therefore be approved.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> YES <input type="checkbox"/> NO</p> <p>PROPOSITION NO. 2 2015-2016 JERICO UFSD CAPITAL RESERVE FUND</p> <p>SHALL the Board of Education, pursuant to Education Law section 3651, be authorized to establish a Capital Reserve Fund known as the "Facilities Improvement Program II – Jericho Public Schools " for the purpose of district-wide roof replacement/renovations, window replacement/renovations, toilet room renovations, masonry/concrete/chimney renovations/replacement, door replacement, interior stair renovations, ceiling/floor/wall replacement, ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) renovations, classroom/lab renovations, cafeteria/kitchen reconstruction/renovations, library/multi media center renovations, electrical renovations, lighting renovations, plumbing renovations, HVAC (heating/ventilation/air conditioning) renovations, boiler replacements/renovations, fire system replacements/renovations, elevator renovations/replacements, carpentry renovations, security renovations, emergency generators, energy efficiency projects, additional new space if necessary, site renovations/reconstruction including asphalt and concrete improvements, fencing, athletic fields renovations/reconstruction, tennis courts renovations/reconstruction, bleacher renovations/replacements, concession stand renovations/additions, playgrounds, lockers renovations/replacements, locker room renovations/reconstruction, gymnasium renovations/reconstruction, pool renovations/reconstruction, weight room renovations/reconstruction, computer/technology upgrades, public address/clock system renovations/replacement, telephone system renovations/replacements, hazardous material remediation, bus garage renovations/additions, auditorium renovations, storage renovations/additions, furnishings and equipment incidental to said projects. The maximum amount of the aforesaid Capital Reserve Fund shall be \$10 million, plus investment income. The term is to be 10 years; the funds are to be transferred from surplus monies remaining in the general fund and/or from existing reserves as allowed by General Municipal and Education Law including a sum not to exceed an annual amount of \$10 million beginning with the 2014-2015 year and in any future year of the term to reach the maximum amount of \$10 million. Upon the establishment and funding of said reserve, the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee shall be directed to deposit monies of this reserve fund in a separate bank account to be known as the "Facilities Improvement Program II –Jericho Public Schools."
